OLD FAITHFUL WINTER EXPEDITION

Some of the stops include the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone and Yellowstone Lake while in search of wildlife, steaming thermal features, pristine winter views, and the true sense of winter wilderness.

NORTHERN RANGE ACCOMMODATIONS

As part of the ongoing improvements to park facilities, the Mammoth Hot Springs Hotel will be closed for the next two winter seasons as it undergoes extensive renovations. Limited services will remain available in Mammoth like snowcoach transportation, and ski shop and dining (both in the Terrace Grill).

While winter lodging will not be available at Mammoth Hot Springs, the town of Gardiner, MT, is just 5 miles north at Yellowstone's North Entrance. Basing in Gardiner, guests still have convenient access to the great wildlife watching and scenery that's found in Lamar Valley and Yellowstone's Northern Range, so no one should miss the chance to experience this incredible area of the park.

There is a \$25 fee for each bag exceeding 50 pounds, and for each additional bags beyond two per traveler for those traveling on snowcoach transportation.
