YOUR ADVENTURE BEGINS

Welcome to the Old Faithful Snow Lodge and thank you for selecting the Total Yellowstone Package.

Please check in between 4:00pm and 5:00pm for your overnight stay. You will check out tomorrow morning so please prepare accordingly.

Baggage handling is included at check-in so feel free to request Bell Porter assistance at the Front Desk prior to parking your automobile.

This evening you will dine at the Old Faithful Snow Lodge Dining Room. Reservations are not required and the Old Faithful Snow Lodge Front Desk Staff will provide you with a meal coupon that will cover the cost of your meal as well as the gratuity.

At 8:00pm you will meet your Adventure Guides and fellow participants for a package orientation and Q&A session in the Snow Lodge. The Front Desk will provide directions to your designated meeting place.

DAY GREAT GEYSERS

Today marks the start of your Yellowstone Adventure!

The Old Faithful Snow Lodge Dining Room will serve you breakfast this morning before you meet everyone in the Old Faithful Snow Lodge lobby. Please check out of your room and take advantage of the included luggage service before meeting your Guides for exploration of the Old Faithful area. Your Guides will plan out the day based on the prediction times of the various geysers in the area.

You will enjoy lunch in the Old Faithful Inn Dining Room.

We will depart the Old Faithful area in the afternoon for our trip along the East side of the Park. The travel route will be east over the Continental Divide and then north along the soothing shores of Yellowstone Lake to the Bridge Bay Marina where you will participate on a relaxing Scenicruise tour.



Canyon Lodge will be the destination for today's journey but first you will travel through Hayden Valley where some of Yellowstone's critters often roam. Be sure to keep your eyes peeled and your optics at the ready!

Upon check in at Canyon Lodge, you will dine at the Canyon Eatery. Reservations are not required so dine at your leisure.

NOTE: The morning walks/tours on this day will be based from Old Faithful and may vary based upon Old Faithful's eruption, weather, group interest, etc. Participants may also use this time as free time. Guides will tailor the morning with each group to provide the ultimate Old Faithful experience.

DAY 03

A GRAND ADVENTURE

Your breakfast will be served in the Canyon Eatery. Please check out of your room and take advantage of the included luggage service before meeting your Guides for a day of waterfalls and wonder. Exploration of the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone is our morning destination. You will witness the breathtaking 109-foot Upper and 308-foot Lower Falls from different vantage points. You will definitely want your camera with you this morning so bring it along.

A lunch break at the Canyon Eatery is on tap before departing the Canyon Area and heading to Mammoth Hot Springs.

This afternoon, your travels will take you north over the highest paved road in the park. See how many different colors of wildflowers you can spot along the way! You'll stop at Tower Fall for a short walk for more views before heading west toward Park Headquarters.

After check-in at the Mammoth Hot Springs Hotel you will dine at the Mammoth Hot Springs Hotel Dining Room. Reservations are not required so feel free to dine when you wish. After dinner, a stroll through Fort Yellowstone could provide a relaxing end to the day.

CRITTERS AND COWBOYS

This morning you will meet your Guides for an early departure. Today will be spent searching for and (hopefully!) observing wildlife while exploring and learning about Yellowstone's magnificent Northern Range and what makes it such fantastic wildlife habitat! Stops will be based on wildlife activity, weather conditions, and group interests, but will include time in the famed Lamar Valley. A field breakfast and lunch is included so we can capitalize on prime wildlife viewing times.



In the afternoon you'll stop at the historic Roosevelt Lodge for a Stagecoach Adventure led by a stage driver and shotgunner.

We will then make our way back to Mammoth Hot Springs for another overnight stay. Tonight is our final night spent at Mammoth so please prepare accordingly. Dinner will again be at the Mammoth Hot Springs Hotel Dining Room. Reservations are not required so dine at your leisure. You will check out in the morning so please prepare accordingly.

DAY 05

WEST SIDE STORY

The Mammoth Hot Springs Hotel Dining Room will serve you breakfast this morning. Please check out of your room and meet your Guides for the final leg of your adventure.

Your journey today will take you back to Old Faithful along the West Side of the park.

Madison picnic area is the designated stop for your field lunch break. After lunch you will leave your Guides and board a 1930's era Historic Yellow Bus for a tour into yesteryear along the Firehole River.

Our primary stop will be the Fountain Paint Pots for a ½ mile walking tour. During this boardwalk trek you will experience an in-depth glimpse into the steaming magnificence of one of each of the four types of thermal features found in Yellowstone.

Upon your return you will check-in to the Old Faithful Snow Lodge and dine in the Old Faithful Snow Lodge Dining Room before meeting your Guides and fellow travelers for a farewell Campfire program. This is your opportunity to share your favorite memories of your adventure and say so-

long to your new friends and Adventure Guides. A campfire favorite may also make an appearance so save some room during dinner!

WHAT TO BRING

The below list of suggested items is not intended to be an all-inclusive list so please bring any other items you may need.

1 piece of luggage with 50-lb wt. limit is allowed per person.

- Daypack/Small Backpack
- · Reusable Water Bottle
- Sunscreen & SPF lip protection
- Sunglasses
- Comfortable, broken-in walking shoes or hiking boots with ankle support
- Socks that prevent hot spots or blistering with moisture wicking properties
- Camera with extra batteries and/or charger plus memory cards
- · Optics for wildlife and scenic viewing
- Snacks
- Clothing layers with UV protection providing thermal insulation from cold and wind as well as relief from the warmer portions of the day. Mountain mornings and evenings are often much cooler with the afternoons being much warmer.
- Hat that provides sun protection
- Bear Spray (if desired, may be sourced locally, but cannot be carried on commercial airlines)
- Full lightweight rain gear or a rain jacket/ poncho at a minimum
- Medication
- Insect repellent
- Downloading Yellowstone apps on your preferred electronic device related to flora, fauna, night skies and park geysers may enhance your experience.

Itineraries are subject to change. Unforeseen cancellations of Program activities due to inclement weather or mechanical difficulties will be supplemented with extended touring routes or alternative activities. Refunds will not be issued for canceled activities.
