## Campground Rules for a safe and enjoyable stay in Yellowstone National Park

- \* In case of emergency, dial 911.
- \* Quiet hours are 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM.

  Generators may not exceed 60 decibels at 50 feet and their use is prohibited from 8:00 PM to 8:00 AM.

  Please do not idle engines.
- \* Washing dishes, clothing, or brushing teeth at outside campground spigots is prohibited.
- \* Wheeled vehicles, including trailers MUST stay on pavement.
- \* Campfires must be in established fire grates and must not be left burning unattended. Please do not put dirt, rocks, or garbage into fire grates.
- \* All wood must fit inside the fire ring.
- \* The cutting or taking of standing wood is prohibited.
- \* You may use dead, down, and detached wood for campfires.
- \* Camping is permitted in designated sites only.
- \* Maximum of six people per campsite.
- \* Keep a clean campsite. All trash, garbage, and litter must be disposed of in the provided bear-proof dumpsters.
- \* Properly store food, utensils, coolers, etc. (see list at right).
- \* Please recycle! See other side for location.
- \* No leveling, digging, or trenching of campsites.
- \* Carry all gray waste water to restrooms for disposal. Pour gray water into restroom dishwashing sinks located between the men's and women's room. No grease please.
- \* No bicycles allowed off the pavement or on trails.
- \* Use of rollerblades / skateboards / scooters is prohibited.
- \* Pets MUST be physically controlled at all times and may not be left unattended.
- \* Pets may not be more than 100 feet from roads and parking areas.
- \* Pets are NOT ALLOWED on trails. Please pick up after your pet.
- \* Restroom electrical outlets for small personal care items only.
- \* Please use caution; always drive slowly while in the campground.

### **CHECK-OUT TIME IS 11:00 AM.**

Please drop your site card in the check-out box upon final departure. If you are planning to leave before your scheduled departure date, you MUST come to the Registration Office with your site card in order to be eligible for a refund. Changes to your reservation will result in a \$25 charge. Cancellation or early departure may result in forfeiture of the amount of one night's stay.



## **WARNING: FOOD and ODORS attract BEARS!**

For your safety, the following items (new, clean, dirty, empty, or full) may NOT be left outside, in tents, or in tent trailers at any time, day or night, unless they are in immediate use.

#### **ANY ITEM WITH AN ODOR**

- \* Food or Food Container
- \* Water and Beverage Containers
- \* Pet Food or Pet Water Containers
- \* Eating, Drinking, or Cooking Utensils
- \* Stoves, Grills, or Hibachis

- \* Ice Chests or Coolers
- \* Trash, Garbage, or Litter
- \* Cosmetics or Toiletries
- \* Dirty dish water
- \* Unsealed Waste Water Containers
- \* Porta-Potty

To ensure your safety, any violation of these regulations may result in a citation and/or confiscation of these items by the National Park Service.

Failure to comply may result in property damage, injury or death of a person and /or the removal or death of a bear from the Yellowstone Ecosystem.

When hiking, carry bear spray and hike in groups of three or more.
