
Welcome to Canyon Lodge

Motorboat Rentals from Bridge Bay Marina

For self-guided adventures, 18-foot outboard motorboats can be rented from the marina.

Guided Fishing or Sightseeing Charters from Bridge Bay Marina

Two-to-twelve-hour tours are available. Your guide will give you a memorable experience taking you to remote locales on one of the highest large lakes in the lower 48 states. Fishing is always an option and all tackle is provided by your guide

Scenicruise on Yellowstone Lake from Bridge Bay Marina

All aboard the Lake Queen II for a one-hour guided tour of Yellowstone Lake, the largest freshwater lake above 7,000 feet in the US. The cruise departs the Bridge Bay Marina with several trips daily. Along the way you will learn about the Lake Area Historical District, view the remains of the SS E.C. Waters, and other amazing features. Watch for eagles, shorebirds, and occasional elk and bison sightings on the shoreline.

Evening Wildlife Encounters

This half day, early evening tour will give the opportunity to explore Lamar Valley in search of wildlife viewing opportunities and expansive views of high meadows in northern Yellowstone. Offered from Mammoth and Canyon.

Circle of Fire Tour

Explore the majority of the Park's famous features on this day tour of the lower loop of the road system – including waterfalls, beautiful landscapes, and thermal features like geysers and hot springs. Offered from Old Faithful, Grant, Canyon and Lake.

Wake up to Wildlife

Enjoy the dawn hours of Lamar Valley on this half day tour with broad vistas and opportunities to spot wildlife. If the wildlife is lying low, the spectacular scenery is sure to please. Offered from Canyon, Mammoth and Roosevelt Lodge.
