## What We Offer

We have dedicated meeting and event space at Mammoth Hot Springs Hotel and Old Faithful Snow Lodge.

Mammoth Hotel is located five miles south of the park's north entrance and Gardiner, MT. The Snow Lodge is located 55 miles south of Mammoth, and 30 miles from park's west entrance at West Yellowstone, MT.

Nine lodging facilities with over 2,000 rooms, accommodations in Yellowstone National Park are plentiful for those wishing to experience the national park in its summertime glory.

# Mammoth Hot Springs Hotel

Mammoth Hot Springs Hotel, the only hotel open year-round in Yellowstone, offers 198 guest accommodations including hotel rooms and separate guest cabins. A full-service dining room, quick service restaurant, and two bars (one serving specialty coffees in the morning) round out the food and beverage options.

Meeting/event space includes a board room and two conference rooms, with over 9,700 square feet of space and capacities ranging from 30 to 350 people, depending on the room and configuration. The variety of spaces can support meetings, small conferences, training sessions, team building activities, breakout sessions, buffet meals, breaks, and receptions.




# Old Faithful Snow Lodge

The Old Faithful Snow Lodge has 134 guest accommodations including lodge rooms and separate guest cabins. Food service includes a full service and quick service restaurant, and lounge.





1 The full conference center includes Minerva, Canary, Opal and the entryway to those rooms. Minerva and Canary conference rooms can be combined into one large room.

2 The Recreation Hall has very limited availability and requires a \$3,000.00 minimum food and beverage sales per day. For events starting prior to 11:30 am you will be required to rent the room the day prior to your event for room set-up.

3 The Dining Room is only available during the summer season for private lunches from 12:00 pm – 3:00 pm.

- A discounted rate for meetings or presentations booking the room for less than 4 hours may be available.
- Additional set-up charges may be assessed for changes to room set-up requested during the daily room rental.
- The room rental fee, which is non-refundable, must be received to confirm booking.
- No outside food or drink is permitted in our facilities.
- In accordance with our quiet hour policy, rental facilities will only be available until 10:00 pm.
- During winter only the Mammoth and Old Faithful Snow Lodge locations are open. These locations are open late December through early March.

Surrounded by Yellowstone National Park's awe-inspiring natural wonders, prepare to indulge in a blend of thoughtfully crafted meals that embrace sustainable practices and showcase the region's bountiful ingredients. Our restaurants strive for 70% of food and beverages to be sourced locally (within 500 miles) and sustainably. Whether you're seeking a moment of dining relaxation or a chance to refuel after an adventurous day of exploration, we have a restaurant to fit your needs



We're able to serve groups with breakfast, lunch and dinner buffet-style meals in the applicable meeting spaces. We also have options for box breakfasts and to-go deli lunches for those groups who are including some park exploration in their agendas. These can be arranged in advance and ready to go when you are.

Looking to enhance your meeting or event with a reception? Beverages, snacks, and hors d'oeuvres, beyond the buffets, it may be possible to provide groups a preset plated menu option in some of our dining rooms\*.

For groups that would like to prepay meals, but offer more choices for their attendees, we also have prepaid meal coupons\*\* that can be used in any of our full-service restaurants.

*\*Some restaurants require dinner reservations and group seatings are spread over multiple seating times and at different tables. Otherwise, group members will be seated on a first come, first served basis as tables come available.*

*\*\*Prepaid meal coupons allow the guest to order from the full menu and the coupon prices include tax, utility fee and gratuity.*

# Details, Details, Details

## Audio Visual Equipment

Audio visual equipment is available including a LCD projector, Flat Screen TV with built-in DVD player, portable screens, permanent screens in some rooms, conference phone, speakers with microphone and iPod/laptop cable.

## Deposits

An advance deposit(s) is required to secure the reservations for any rooms, meals and/or tours and activities. The amount and due dates for the deposits can vary based on the specific services reserved.

## Guarantees

Attendance count guarantees are required in advance of the event, function, meeting, or conference.

## Outside Food Vendors

Xanterra is an authorized concessioner of the National Park Service. As such, we are solely responsible for providing conference services, and related services in our facilities. Outside caterers are not permitted to provide services in our facilities. Wedding cakes are the only outside food and beverage allowed.

## Park Entrance Fees

The National Park Service charges a fee to enter the park. These fees can be paid at the time of entrance. Generally, for non-commercial vehicles, the current fees\* are as follows and are good for entry into Yellowstone National Park for seven days from the date of purchase.

- Private, non-commercial vehicle: \$35
- Motorcycle or snowmobile: \$30
- Individual (by foot, bicycle, ski, etc.): \$20/person

Annual passes can also be purchased in advance through the National Park Service.

## Parking

Parking is free in designated areas once inside the National Park boundaries.

## Room Rental Fees

Room rental fees may be required and are due in advance to confirm a facility rental reservation.

## Tax rates

Yellowstone National Park encompasses three states and two counties. Our hotels and lodges are all within the state of Wyoming, and split between Park and Teton Counties. The room and sales tax rates vary between the two counties. The appropriate sales tax will be applied to all events, unless a current completed Streamline Sales and Use Tax agreement form is provided.

## Utility Fees


The cost of providing in-park utilities is covered through a utility fee separate from the product prices or taxes. One hundred percent of all utility fee collections are dedicated to the upgrade, maintenance, and operation of the Park's utility infrastructure.



# Not Hard to Get To, Hard To Leave

Off the beaten path in a good way. Our proximity to Bozeman, MT (75 miles) makes it easy to get here any time of year. If you are looking to fly or drive, other options are Cody, WY to the east (55 miles to the east entrance), Jackson, WY to the south (55 miles from the south entrance) and West Yellowstone, MT at the west entrance.

NOTE: Year-round access is only through the north entrance and is best accessed via Bozeman. Other entrances are seasonal and access is limited to certain dates.



## We'll Drive, You Enjoy the Ride

We have a fleet of sedans, vans, mini and full-size buses that can be chartered for transportation services including airport shuttles and in-park transportation and touring. We can pick up at most surrounding gateway communities (Bozeman, MT; West Yellowstone, MT; Jackson, WY; and Cody, WY) with ample advance notice and based on available vehicles.
