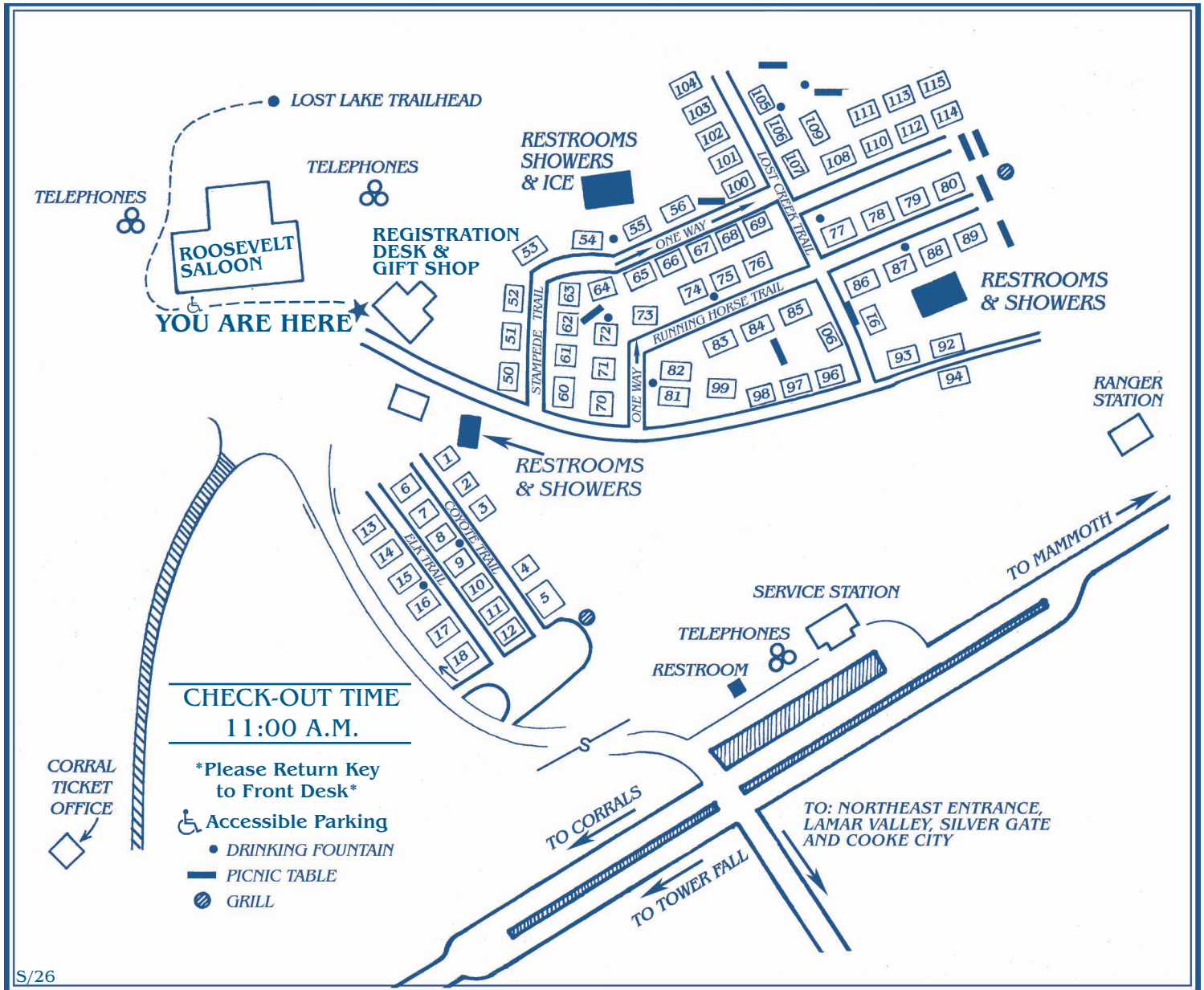


# Welcome to Roosevelt Lodge

### Wake up to Wildlife

Enjoy the dawn hours of Lamar Valley on this half day tour with broad vistas and opportunities to spot wildlife. If the wildlife is lying low, the spectacular scenery is sure to please. Offered from Canyon, Mammoth, and Roosevelt Lodge.

### Whoa Partner!

Take the time to "slow down and smell the sage brush" as you and your horse mosey along the trail. One-hour horseback rides are offered throughout the day. Two-hour horseback rides are offered once a day.

### Morning on the Range

Enjoy a 2-hour historical tour of Pleasant Valley in a horse-drawn wagon to the site of Uncle John Yancey's Hotel, which welcomed guests from 1884 to 1906. At the hotel site, where the foundation stones can still be found, enjoy hot coffee, tea, or juice, a morning snack, and a campfire while hearing stories of this unique corner of Yellowstone and its part in the early exploration of the area.

### Old West Dinner Cookout

Head out from Roosevelt Lodge for some cowboy grub and tall tales! Feast on sizzling steaks, our famous Roosevelt baked beans, potato salad, corn, coleslaw, corn muffins, watermelon, and fruit crisp. It's all served up with music, storytelling, wranglers, horses, and wagons.

### Go Western with a Stagecoach Adventure

Energize your pioneer spirit on a stagecoach ride. Feel the rumble of the replica Tally-ho coach. Hear about the history of the stagecoaches in Yellowstone. Offered throughout the day from the Roosevelt corral.

## FOOD & ODORS ATTRACT BEARS

The following items (new, clean, dirty, empty or full) may NOT be left outside, in tents, or in tent trailers at any time, DAY OR NIGHT, unless they are in immediate use!

- COOKING UTENSILS
- EATING UTENSILS
- DRINKING UTENSILS
- STOVES
- BEVERAGE CONTAINERS
- GRILLS
- COOLERS
- ICE CHESTS
- TRASH OR TRASH BAGS (in the site or fire pit)
- FOOD
- COSMETICS
- TOILETRIES
- PET FOOD
- PET FOOD BOWLS
- PET WATER BOWLS
- PAILS
- BUCKETS
- WASH BASINS
- ANY ITEM WITH FOOD ODOR

A violation of these rules may result in a CITATION and/or confiscation of these items!!

**THE BEARS FUTURE AND THE SAFETY OF OTHERS DEPENDS ON YOU!**

- Service at the Roosevelt Lodge Dining Room is first come, first seated.
- Housekeeping starts work at 8 am. Please place your “Do Not Disturb” sign on your door if you do not wish to be disturbed.
- Please do not use any outside wood in the stove, as it is a fire hazard.
