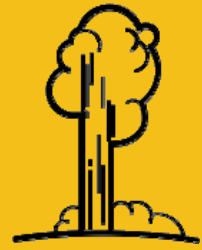




Living at Old Faithful

Weather: Summer: Daytime temperatures are often in the 70s (25c) and occasionally in the 90s (35c). Nights are usually cooler and temperatures may drop below freezing.

Thunderstorms are common in the afternoons. Spring & Fall: Daytime temperatures range from 30s to 60s (0 to 20c) with overnight lows in the teens to single digits (-5c to -20c). Snow is common in spring and fall. At any time of year, be prepared for sudden changes. Always be equipped with a wide range of clothing options. Be sure to bring a warm jacket and rain gear, even in the summer.

Guest facilities:

As a national historic landmark, **Old Faithful Inn** is a rustic-style lodge, with log and wood shingle exterior and is located adjacent to the world famous Old Faithful Geyser. The original part of the Inn, known as the “Old House” was completed in 1904 and includes an immense lobby with a huge fireplace. The East and West Wings were added in the teens and the twenties. A full service restaurant, deli, gift store and interpretive tours are available at the Inn.

Old Faithful Lodge is a historic cabin facility located near Old Faithful Inn and includes a one-story main lodge built in the 1920’s featuring massive logs and stone pillars. The lobby and food court (with cafeteria, bakery and espresso outlets) offers tremendous view of the Old Faithful Geyser. The large gift store is also located in the lodge. Basic cabins are located nearby.

Old Faithful Snow Lodge was completed in 1999. The Snow Lodge is the newest of the park’s full service hotels and offers a warm welcome to summer and winter visitors. The lodge is of heavy timber construction, has exterior log columns and a cedar shingle roof. Accommodations include lodge rooms and western cabins. A full service family dining room, a fast food outlet Geyser Grill, and gift shop round out the amenities. In winter, visitors take a snow coach or snowmobile to the Snow Lodge, which is a hub of snowy adventures, offering Nordic skiing, snowshoeing and a launching point for a variety of unique over snow explorations of the park’s interior.

Employee facilities:

Employees live in residences located throughout the area. **Bitterroot, Columbine, Larkspur, Laurel, Lupine, Obsidian** and **Paintbrush**. Some residence facilities are a 15 minute walk from the work sites and employees dining rooms. **Bitterroot, Larkspur, Lupine, Paintbrush,** and **Obsidian** are two-story buildings with semi-private bathrooms, and house approximately 100 employees each (2 per room). **Columbine** and **Laurel** are also two-story facilities and have community bathrooms and 2 or 3 persons per room. Each residence facility has a lobby area, laundry room and pay phone.

The Inn and Snow Lodge each have an Employee Dining Room (EDR). An employee Recreation Hall, with work-out equipment and sports court is located at the Lodge. The Employee Pub is within walking distance of the residences. These facilities serve all Old Faithful employees.
